SEAFAIR AND BITE OF SEATTLE

Many small communities host summer festivals. These giant barbecues can attract thousands of residents, vendors, artists, and performers over the course of several days. Now imagine such a festival on a far grander scale – an entire metropolitan area celebrating the peak of summer. Hundreds of thousands of people come out for a month of activities and events. There are concerts, air shows, boat races, food festivals, parades, and street performers, to name a few. Imagine, but only until you see it for yourself during Seattle's traditional SEAFAIR and Bite of Seattle celebrations, scheduled for July 10th – August 8th.

The premier summer celebration of the Northwest, SEAFAIR has grown over the past half-century to include demonstrations by the U.S. Navy, including an air show by the Blue Angels; a scholarship competition for young women; races featuring hydroplanes, boats that cruise at speeds in excess of 200 mph; and athletic contests, including a marathon and a triathlon. Events take place over the course of a month, making this one of the longest annual celebrations in a metropolitan area! Bite of Seattle, the city's premier food festival for the last 22 years, is held during the first few days of SEAFAIR. Nearly half a million people come to sample food from more than 60 area restaurants over the course of three days. Both celebrations have become exceptionally popular in Seattle and across the Northwest. If you haven't experienced it before, come join us this year! CORNUCOPIA DAYS – JULY 8-11

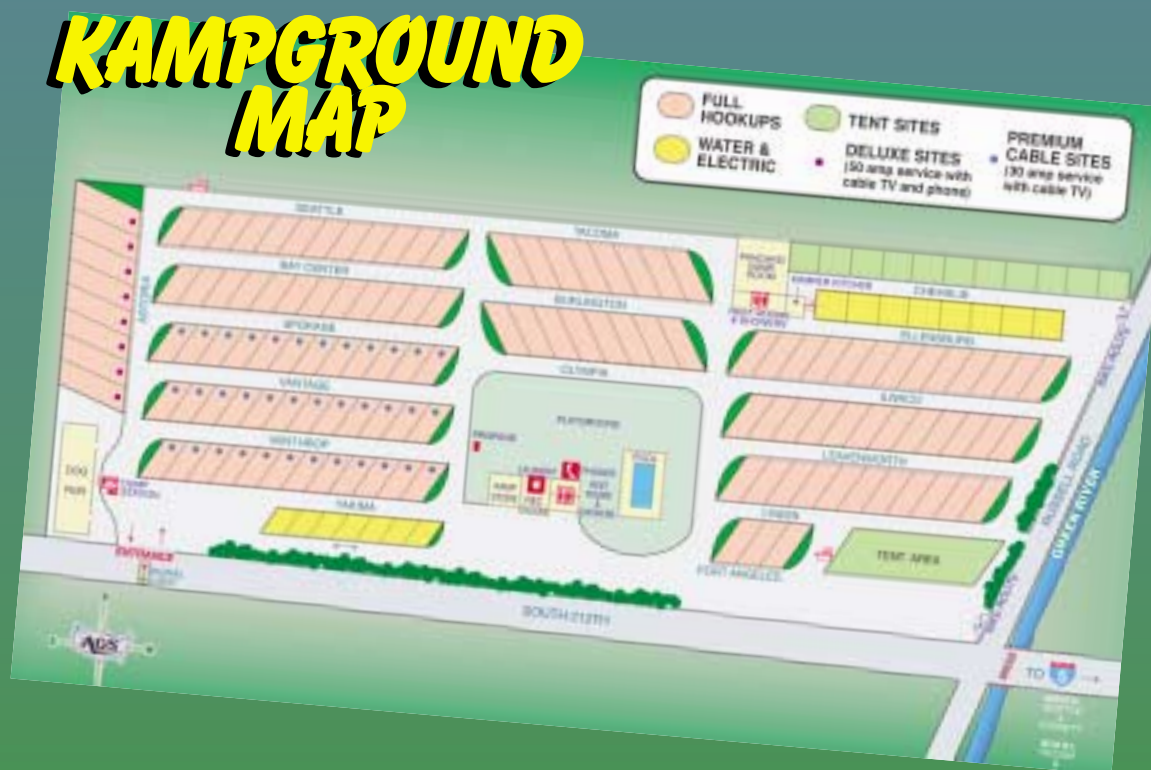
